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Dear Graduating Senior:

The Asian Chamber of Commerce will award Five - \$1000 student scholarship to graduating Seniors from who best fits the criteria listed below.

Applications will be evaluated on the following:

- Graduating Senior of Asian descent
- Academics (GPA > 3.0, high school transcript)
- Essay (typed, 200-300 words)
- Community service and/or employment
- School activities (clubs, sports)
- Interview (10 minutes), if needed

Scholarship Process:

1. Application forms are available at the Asian of Chamber office or online at **www.asianchamber-hou.org**. All graduating seniors of Asian descent in the Houston metro area are eligible.
2. The applicant will complete and return the typed application to the Chamber by the deadline date of March 1, 2006.
3. GPA must be 3.0 or higher.
4. The essay must be typed & the sole product of the applicant.
5. A copy of your high school transcript must be attached.

Applications will be reviewed and the top finalist(s) from may be asked to attend a 10 minute interview. If an interview is necessary, the finalist(s) will be notified of the date and time of the interview. Recipients of the scholarships will be announced at the May Asian Chamber of Commerce Luncheon.

Purpose:

The student scholarship awards are designed to aid deserving academically oriented students in furthering their education.

Persons Eligible to Apply for Grants:

Applicants must be graduating high school seniors who have been, or anticipate being, accepted to an accredited institution.

Due Date:

March 1, 2006 is the deadline date. Late applications will not be accepted!

Selection Process:

1. Applications will be reviewed by the Student Scholarship Application Review Committee, which will be consisted of the Committee Chairman & any number of committee members designated by the Chairman.
2. Finalists will be notified of the date and time of the interview (if committee members deem it necessary).
3. The approval decision by the Committee is final.
4. Recipients will be notified of the final decisions by May 1, and the awards will be presented at the May membership luncheon. The check will be made payable to both the scholarship recipient and the institution of higher learning.

Community Activities: Scouts, Church, Volunteer, Employment, etc. (indicate dates and responsibilities)

Essay:

Please attach a typed 200-300 word essay about your educational and career goals. Content, spelling, grammar and style will be considered.

Affidavit:

I do hereby certify that the information provided is correct to the best of my knowledge. I also understand that if I do not present my scholarship check to my college/university in 120 days, I will forfeit the funds.
